Positive Consequences:

If the essential agreement is followed Students will receive class awards and the class will earn marbles in the jar for good behaviour which will earn them vouchers and a class reward.

Negative consequences:

If the essential agreement is not followed by a student there will be 3 verbal warnings, if the behaviour does not improve, students will have to write negative behaviour into our behaviour book which will be shown to parents if behaviour persists.

If more than 3 notes are put into the behaviour book in one day, that person will miss out on free time Friday. Instead of free time Friday they will re-write the entire essential agreement and take it home to be signed by their parents.

If the essential agreement is not followed by the class as a group, there will be 3 verbal warnings, if the behaviour does not improve, the class may lose marbles.

If more than 3 marbles are lost in one day, the whole class will miss out on free time Friday. Instead of free time Friday the class will re-write the entire essential agreement and take it home to be signed by their parents.

If behaviour persists for more than a week, parents will be contacted, and Mrs O'Connor may be informed.
