We are knowledgeable when we explore new ideas and strategies, because this helps us to learn new things.

We can make connections in our learning and explore concepts that have global importance.

We are balanced by knowing the difference between play and work, it is important to understand the difference between mental, physical and emotional balance so we are happy and healthy.

4LK is principled because they follow the rules in the yard and the classroom. It is important to always tell the truth.

We show caring by helping others, anyway possible. We respect other people and their feelings, while looking out for each other.

We are inquirers by using our knowledge and skills to plan our work. As inquirers we have a natural urge to learn new things.

In **4LK** we are good communicators, we listen and talk to each other respectfully while sharing our ideas and feelings with others to help them understand us.

When we are at school we make responsible decisions by first thinking about our actions. We use our thinking skills to improve our learning.

We are reflective on what we learn by asking questions. Being reflective helps us to understand what we have learnt and identify our strengths and weaknesses.

In **4LK** we use our strengths to help others and our weaknesses to set goals for improvement.

Creativity means using lots of different types of colour, shapes and patterns to create art. I am being creative when I use my imagination and skills to produce detailed work and think critically about problems.

We try to understand how other people feel and lead them through hard situations.

We show cooperation by working together nicely, by using teamwork to achieve goals.

Integrity means being fair and honest toward friends and classmates. In **4LK** we are always honest, even if we make a mistake.

In **4LK** we are always ready for learning. We show enthusiasm by trying new experiences and we want to learn new things every day.

We show respect to the environment by throwing away our rubbish and not littering. We are polite to people and show manners while understanding the importance of being respectful to people places and things.
