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Dear Parents / Guardians,

The Grade Two's have begun the fifth inquiry on How we organize ourselves. The central idea for the inquiry is, 'Communities have services to support everyone's health and wellbeing.' The lines of inquiry are:

- *Councils provide services for the community's wellbeing*
- *Health and wellbeing services meet our needs*
- *The importance of community services*

As part of the inquiry process, children are required to bring in an artefact that represents the central idea and lines of inquiry. It is important that students participate in this process, as they will need to make connections with the inquiry. They will also be completing a reflection about their artefact and it will be placed in their portfolios.

Below are some ideas of artefacts that they can bring in to share with the class:

1. Books- A book that shows services that support our health and/or wellbeing.
2. Posters- Children can create a poster. On the poster they can draw pictures of services that support our health and wellbeing.
3. Photos/pictures of health and wellbeing services.
4. Children can write about health and wellbeing services.
5. Make a booklet about different health and wellbeing services.
6. Toys/objects of support services eg: ambulance, police car, first aid kit etc.

Please note that this list is simply a guide. Students can choose something else however, please ensure that it relates to our inquiry and that your child can explain its relevance.
