GRADE THREE POLLY WOODSIDE AND STATE LIBRARY EXCURSION

Dear Parents / Guardians,

The Year Three students have commenced a new unit of inquiry and are inquiring into the central idea of “Explorations are a response to challenges and opportunities”. Students will use the concept of reflection as a lens to inquire into the explorations of people throughout time and the challenges they encountered. To assist and help students go further during the inquiry process, the Year Three Learning Community has organised an excursion that will provide them with a depth of knowledge to use throughout their upcoming learning experiences. Students will be visiting the Polly Woodside at The Docklands for a workshop and then attend the ‘Burke and Wills’ workshop at the State Library which is located at 328 Swanston Street, Melbourne. Students will have a valuable opportunity to tour and view the exhibits throughout the State Library. These two experiences will also be used as provocations for our next inquiry in the second semester on communities.

The Grade Three students will be attending the workshop on one of the following days:

Wednesday the 13th September: 3NM, 3MB and 3SP

Wednesday the 20th September: 3KM, 3MW and 3KW

The cost of the excursion will be **\$23.00**, which includes the Polly Woodside Workshop, The State Library Education Program and cost for the bus.
