Communicators

Inquirers

- Work as a team by sharing, taking turns and supporting each other in our learning.
- Being time wise and always be in control of our learning.

3KW Positive Consequences:

1. Positive feedback and praise.
2. Group Points/weekly prize draw
3. Free time activities eg. Free drawing, writing etc
4. Assembly awards.
5. Games - inside/outside
6. Background Music
7. Movies on wet day break times.

3KW Negative Consequences:

1. Verbal warning to make a change. Refer back to essential agreement.
2. Reminder to change behaviour warning of consequence if don't.
3. Last warning - Consequence: time out, reflection sheet, writing out Essential Agreement, an apology letter.
4. For repeat offenders or a serious event student to be sent to an AP or DP. A meeting set up with Mrs O'Conner/Mrs Lee and parents if required.
